**6 OAK**— Lacey-Mae H—You have shown wonderful empathy by looking out for your friend and standing up for an injustice on the playground, bangarang!

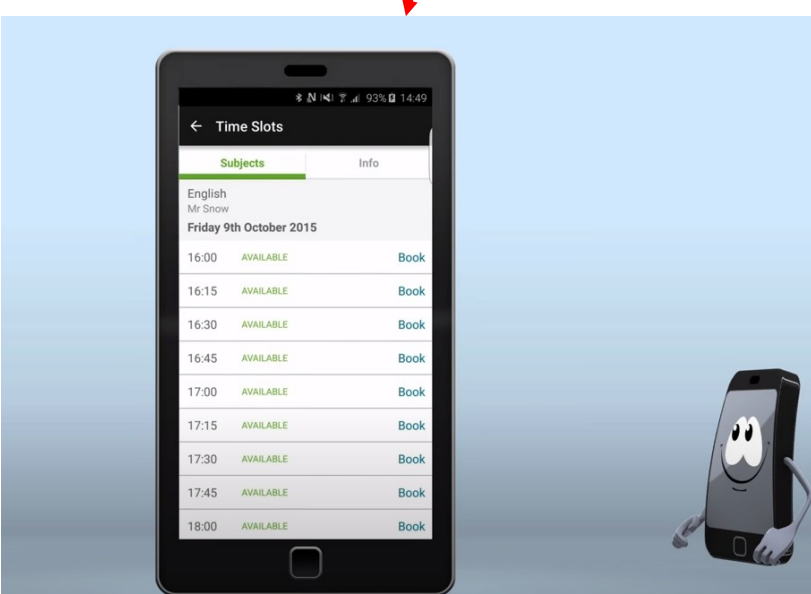
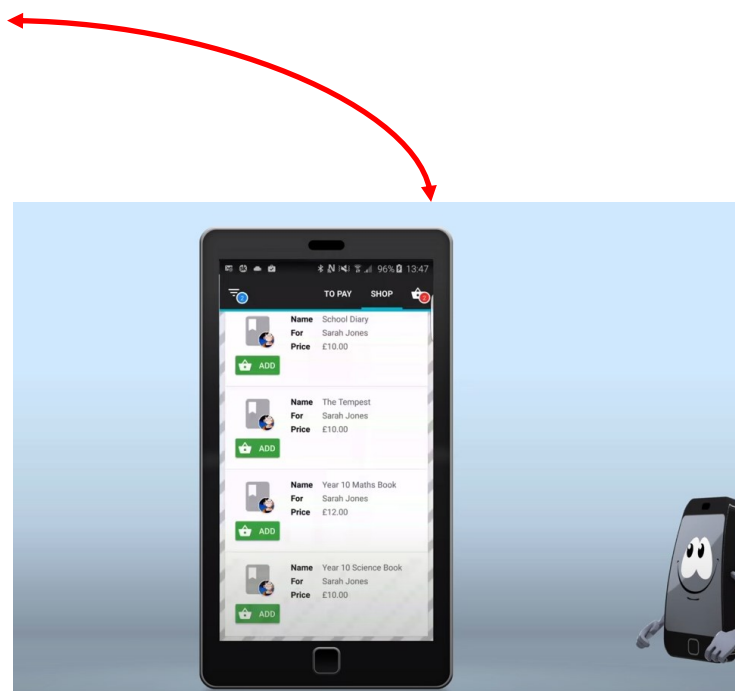
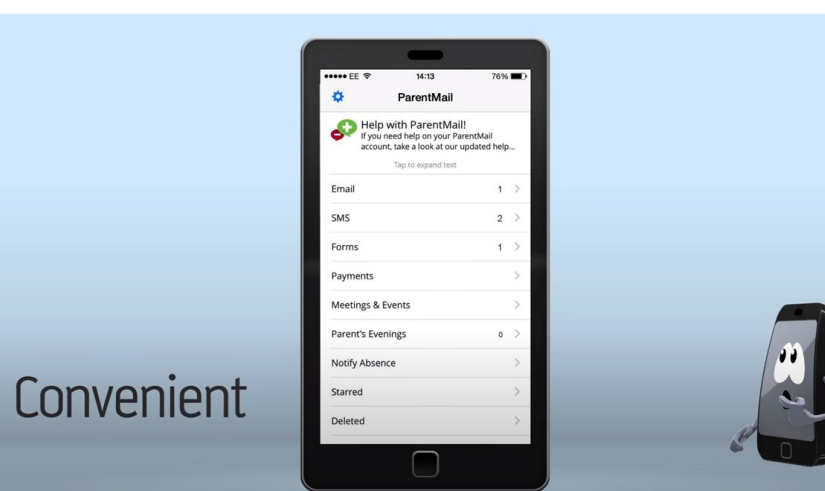
# ParentMail Payments Help Guide
