

6 OAK— Logan H—You made excellent connections between your extensive knowledge of World War Two and what you saw at Eden Camp, bangarang dude!

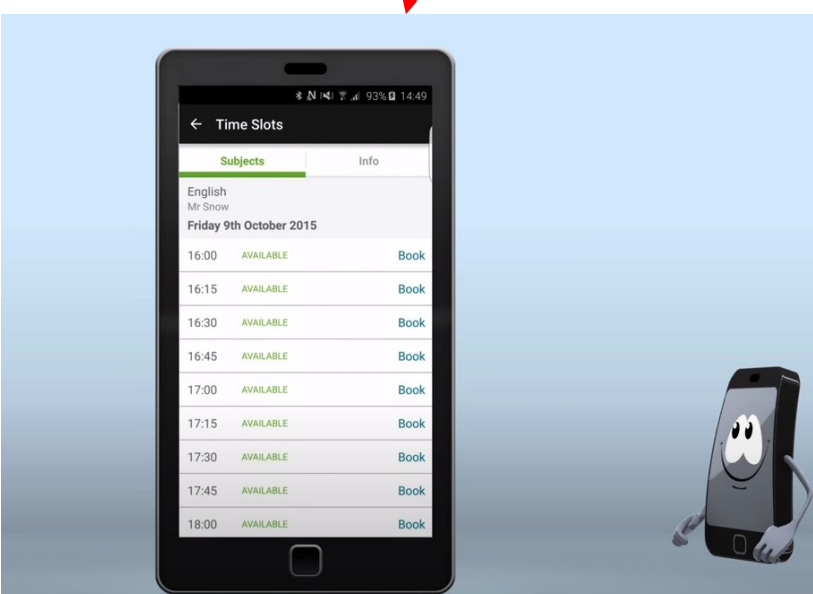
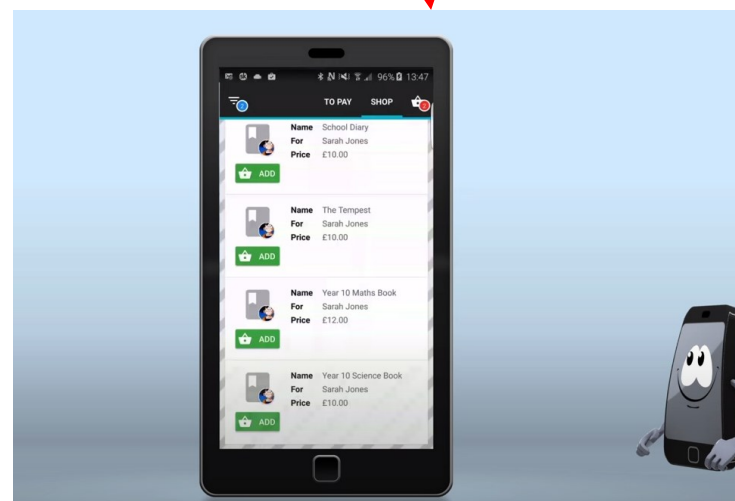
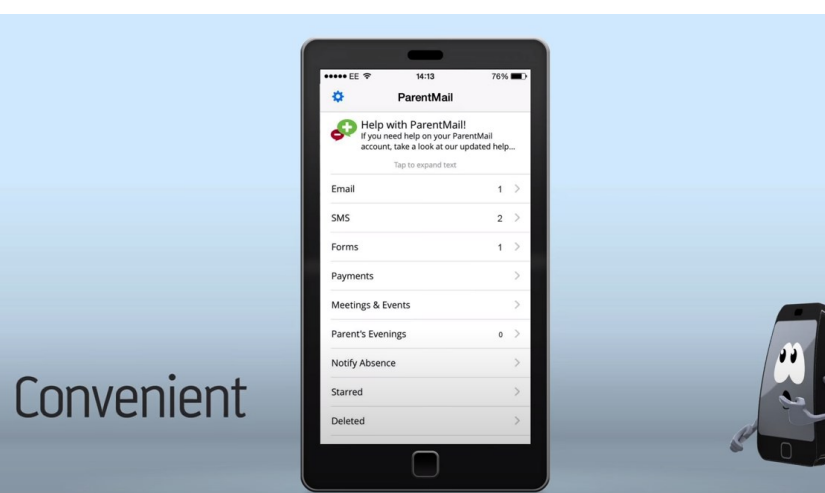
ParentMail Payments Help Guide

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may already be aware, one of our families has recently been going through a turbulent time and we are hoping to raise some much-needed funds and awareness by holding a raffle, bake-sale and non-uniform day on Friday 26th May 2023.

In Autumn last year, Malakai in Year 3 was diagnosed with Fanconi Anaemia, which is a rare disorder that causes, amongst other things, bone marrow failure. Malakai quickly became extremely unwell due to this, with the only treatment for bone marrow failure being a bone marrow transplant. The search for a donor was immediate and urgent. Malakai had to have weekly blood transfusions to keep him alive. Fortunately, Malakai's younger sister – Eliza in Year 1 – was a match and so Malakai could have a bone marrow transplant. First, he had to undergo chemotherapy and an extended hospital stay. After that, both children had to stay at home for several weeks in isolation to ensure they did not pick up any other illnesses. Then, Eliza had to attend hospital in order to donate her bone marrow before Malakai could have his transplant. As you can imagine, this has been a very difficult time both emotionally and financially for the whole family and as such we would like to do something to help raise some funds and awareness – both for the family and some of the charities and organisations that have supported them while they have been going through this. Both children have been so brave, and Malakai is now recovering well at home. If you are able to, please consider registering as a bone marrow donor – the wait for matches and transplants can be long and you might just save someone's life, as Eliza has done for her big brother. Mum and dad have been amazing, coping with the most devastating set of circumstances but finding the strength to support both the children and each other on this journey that no parent ever wants to have to go on - and we're sure you'll want to help them as much as we do.

Fundraising Day – Friday 26th MAY - with money raised going to: Anthony Nolan, Candlelighters & Malakai/Eliza's Family

Malakai just loves superheroes, and we think he has been such a hero himself throughout all of this that we would like to invite all the children to come to school dressed as their heroes (think superheroes or real-life heroes) for a donation. We will also hold a bake-sale throughout the day and after school, so please bring donations of cakes/buns etc and 50p if you would like to buy a bun. Finally, in the run-up to the day itself we will be doing a raffle. If you have any prizes to donate, please get in touch with Mrs Burling or Mrs Tweed and keep an eye out for the raffle tickets being sold on the playgrounds/gates over the next two weeks (£1 a strip).
