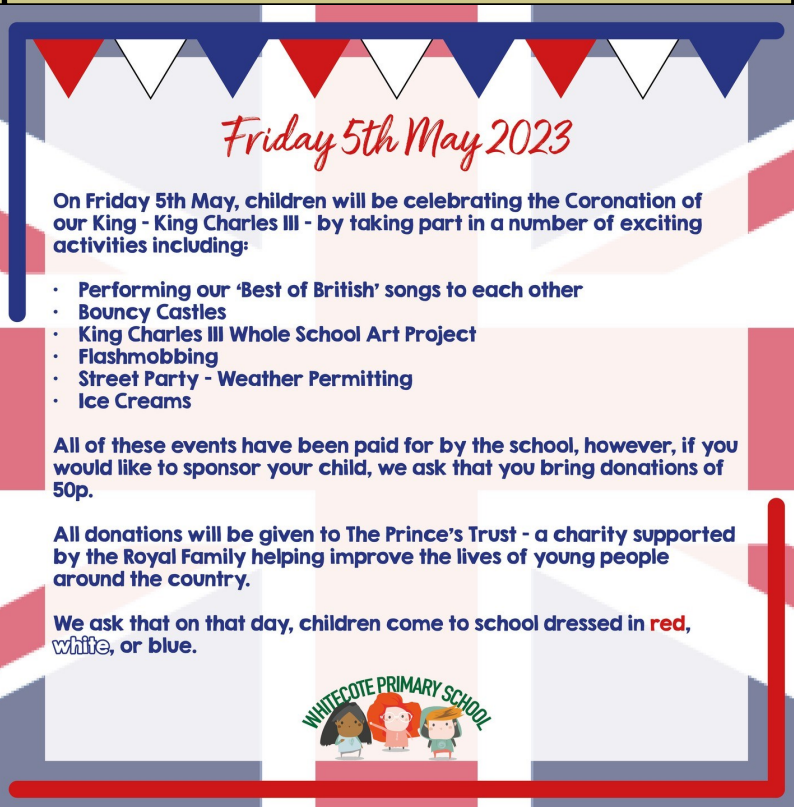

6 OAK— Aimee C— You have been joining in enthusiastically with all our revision sessions , even when you didn't need to be in school—Bangarang!

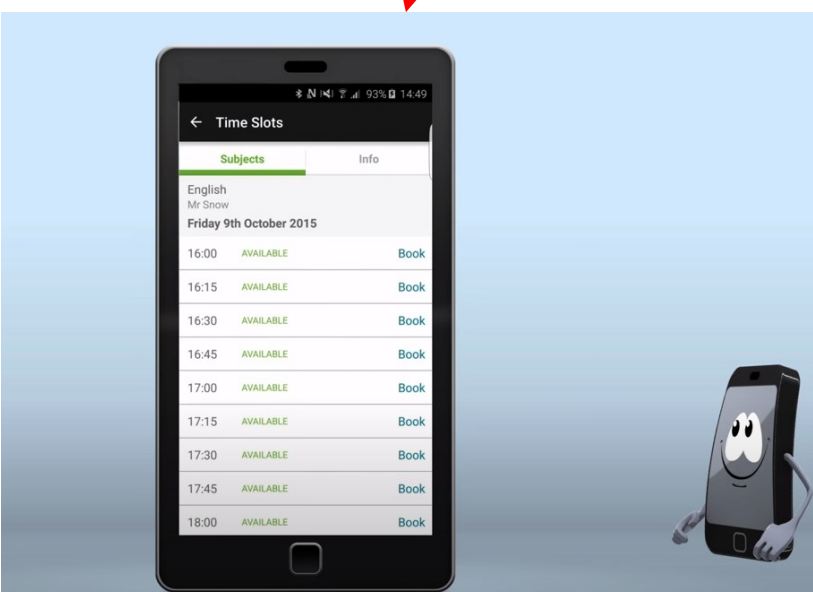
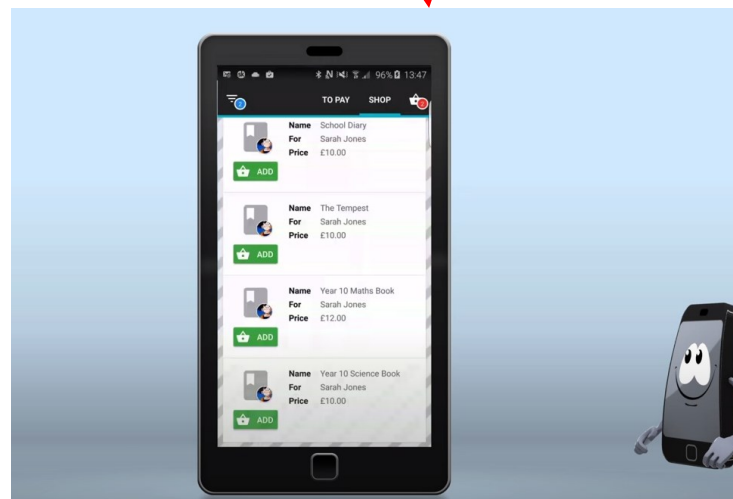
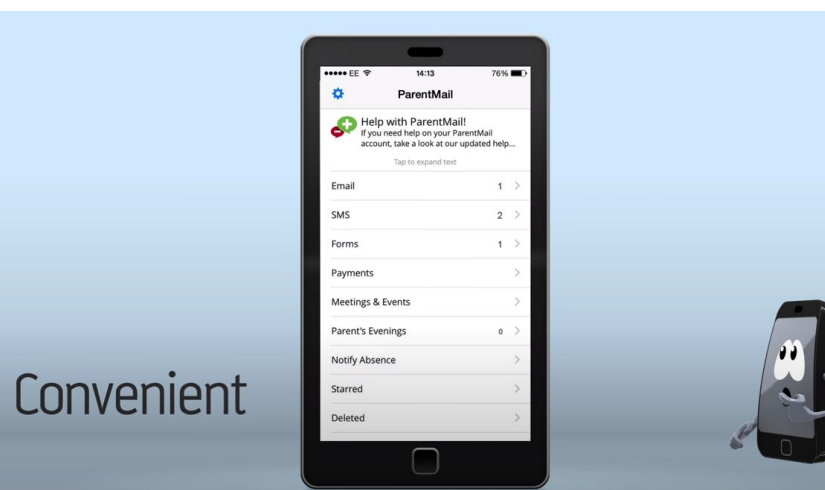
ParentMail Payments Help Guide
