5 Elm– All of Elm- You squeezed every ounce of learning from your trip to Murton Park and wrote great recounts.


6 Cedar– Alice D- you never stop working! It's a pleasure to see someone so hardworking and inspired by their learning. You'll go far!




To access the main menu, use the three lines to the left hand side of the app or webpage. You will then have access to the menu as shown on the right.





Choose to add to basket (if you have multiple items/ multiple children to add items for) or pay now to be taken straight to checkout.



Some items, such as trips require you to give consent before you can checkout. To do this click the parental consent slide button.

From the basket/ pay now option you can then check out as you would online shopping.

Free School Meals



All children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 at a state funded school or academy, will automatically get free school meals through the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme. Parents do not need to make an application to receive these meals.

If you receive benefits and your child already gets Universal Infant Free School Meals, you should still register for free school meals. This is so school can claim funding to support your child at school. This is called Pupil Premium.

Children in Year 3 or above, are only eligible for free school meals if their parents or carers are entitled to benefits, and they make an application for free school meals. Children may be eligible for free school meals if their parents or carers receive any of the following benefits:

- Income support
- Income based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190
 - The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit
 - The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - Universal Credit with an annual income of less than £7,400

If you get Working Tax Credit your child will not qualify for free school meals.

If you live in Leeds and you do not already receive Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support, you will need to complete the <u>online form</u> to claim for Free School Meals. Alternatively, see Miss Johnson in the school office for an application form.
