Curriculum Information

English

In writing, we will be covering the following text types: character description, persuasive writing, explanation and poetry. In reading, we will look at the following texts: Jane Eyre (simplified version), The Brontes – Children of the Moors and Meet Me at the Steelmen.

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing with decimals. We will also cover money, time and position/direction. We will continue to work on the 4 operations in arithmetic sessions, and we will complete the multiplication check in June.

Science

In science, we will be learning about teeth and the digestive system. We will learn the names of the organs that make up the digestive system and complete some investigations.

Humanities

In geography, we will be focusing on erosion. We will focus on coastal erosion and what causes it. We will also look at the differences between geology and petrology.

Art / Design Technology

In DT, we will practise sewing skills. We will look at different toys and their features. We will then design and create our own soft toy, using the skills that we have learnt.

PE

In PE, we will continue with our Friday swimming sessions. We will also be focusing on the skills needed for athletics.

Computing

In computing, we will use Scratch (coding) and the Makey Makeys: <https://scratch.mit.edu/about> and https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-X3hb__YynM.

Other

In music, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. We will also use Charanga to support our learning. We will listen to, discuss, improvise, compose and perform musical pieces. In Spanish, we will continue to build on the vocabulary that we have already learnt. We will also recap our previous learning to make sure we remember it. In PSHE, we will be looking at food choices, role models and similarities/differences. The MindMate lesson will be about coping in difficult situations.
