Curriculum Information

English

Children will build their writing stamina in preparation for secondary school, using a broad range of grammatical structures, and ambitious vocabulary. We will be reading the playscript for our Y6 production; Jill and Fred Historical Hysterical Adventure and developing our drama skills to rehearse and perform the play.

Maths

We will ensure that all maths units are revisited and consolidated prior to children starting high school. Children will have weekly units of money, time, shape, place value, four operations and fractions, decimals and percentages. In addition to this, children will be using and applying their mathematical knowledge to budget and fundraise for our y6 leavers party.

Science

Children will develop their understanding of anatomy and biology as we learn about the various systems in the human body, with a specific focus on the circulation system. The children will also begin reading the class novel: "Pig Heart Boy to compliment their scientific understanding.

Humanities

In history, our topic is the Best of British, where we will be looking at a range of historical inventions, discoveries, events and even revisiting our learning about the British Monarchs. Children will have the opportunity to consolidate their understanding of the chronology of British history and develop their understanding of the British Values and what makes us the wonderful country we are today.

Art / Design Technology

Art, DT and music will all be combined as the children rehearse, develop, design and choreograph their own Year 6 leavers production throughout the summer term. This will include learning lines, performing, singing, dancing and set and costume design in addition to organising the logistics, designing the posters, producing the tickets and using this performance as a way to fundraise for their residential.

We will be enjoying the warmer weather and practicing for sports day by developing our athletic skills, in particular building our overall fitness and stamina through weekly timed runs.

Other

In year 6, every child has the opportunity to learn how to play the ukulele, the children are continuing to learn a range of chords and even play whole songs, including songs by Ed Sheeran, George Ezra and The Greatest Showman. In this unit pupils will learn all about 6 superheroes in the foreign language via colourful and immersive lessons. Pupils will introduced to a series of colours and high frequency verbs to help describe each superhero character (I am called, I have, I live, I am and I am able to). Each lesson will be accompanied by a song that pupils will be encouraged to actively participate in.
