Curriculum Information

Literacy, including Communication and Language

Some of the books we will be looking at this half-term are: Mad about Minibeasts, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Kings Coronation, Jack and the Beanstalk and Hooray for Birds.

Phonics

We will be focussing on aspect, 5, 6, and 7 phonics to help support our understanding of alliteration, voice sounds and how to blend the sounds that adults say into words.

Maths

We will be singing number songs to help us count to 5, such as: Five Little Spacemen and Five Little Speckled Frogs. We will also be learning about shapes and patterns. We will talk about the different patterns we see in nature. E.g. The spots on a ladybird, stripes on a bee, the symmetrical wings of a butterfly.

Physical Development

We will play a piece of music called 'Fantasy in C' by Georg Philipp Telemann. We will encourage the children to create a butterfly dance and explore different ways of moving to the music. The children could incorporate the following: different heights (moving while stretched up tall and while crouched down), moving different parts of their body (for example sweeping arms high and low), listening to the tempo of the music (speeding up and slowing down with it), stopping to visit flowers for nectar as they travel around.

PSHE

We will be talking to the children about how they are feeling about spring. Are they excited about all the different festivals coming up, such as Easter, Mothering Sunday? Do they celebrate any of these festivals? How do the celebrations make them feel?

Understanding the World

We will visit the Wildlife area to explore and investigate the minibeasts that can be found. We will have caterpillars in class so we can learn about the life cycle of a butterfly and frogspawn in the outdoor area so we can learn about the lifecycle of a frog. We will also be planting seeds and watching them grow. We will talk about the parts of a plant and what it needs to

grow. We will be learning about Eid and how people celebrate the festival.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will use percussion instruments to make sounds to accompany different minibeasts. We will encourage the children to think about which instrument would be best for each minibeast and how they should be played (quiet/loud, slow/fast). We will make minibeasts using a range of materials such as box modelling, playdough, clay and loose parts.
