Spring 2 Year: Nursery Parent Curriculum Map

February 20th - 31st March

Curriculum Information

Literacy, including Communication and Language

We will be looking at different stories this half-term to support our understanding of farms and animals. Some of the books we will be looking at are: Mr. Wolf's Pancakes, Scarecrow's Wedding, Chicken Licken, and We're Going on an Egg Hunt.

Phonics

We will be focussing on aspect, 3, 4, and 5 phonics to help support our understanding of body percussion, rhythm and rhyme, and alliteration. We will also be learning how to blend the sounds that adults say into words.

Maths

We will be singing number songs to help us count to 5, such as: Five Little Ducks, Five Little Speckled Frogs, and 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Once I Caught A Fish Alive.

Physical Development

We will explore different ways of moving as represented by different spring events, activities and objects, e.g. jumping like a bunny, growing tall like a flower, skipping like a lamb, splashing in puddles. We will also play a movement game based on different types of farm animals. Children will explore using the space and create different actions for the farm animals, such as galloping like a horse, rolling in mud like a pig, waddling like a duck or pecking like a chicken. They could also practise standing still like a scarecrow!

PSHE

We will be talking to the children about how they are feeling about spring. Are they excited about all the different festivals coming up, such as Easter, Mothering Sunday? Do they celebrate any of these festivals? How do the celebrations make them feel?

Understanding the World

We will discuss different types of animals found on farms. We will encourage the

children to talk about their own experiences. We will talk about adult and baby farm animals and their names. We will also be hatching chicks in nursery and watching how they grow.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be doing observational drawings/ paintings of daffodils and creating a chick collage.
