Curriculum Information

English

For reading we will be looking at comprehension skills; focusing again on retrieval and then moving into inferring what a character is thinking and feeling from what has been written in the text. We are also focussing on understanding by asking children to summarise what they read in their own words.

Maths

In Maths, we will be we will be looking at fractions including finding fractions of amounts, equivalent fractions, ordering fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.

Science

We are starting our topic of 'Animals including Humans'. Some of the areas we will look at are skeletons, food chains, comparing humans and animals.

Humanities

Ancient Greece – a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.

Art / Design Technology

Our DT project is making Greek Togas. Looking to use stitching to join fabrics to create a garment. In Art we will be creating Greek body sculptures out of a range of materials.

PE

Indoor P.E. this half term will be Dance. Outdoor P.E. this half term will be badminton. Please ensure that children can remove their own earrings.

Other

In music this half term we will continue our work on singing a variety of genres. In languages, we are looking at colours, food and days of the week/months of the year. In RE, we will be looking at Greek gods, myths and legends. Our PSHE topic is sex and relationship education. We will learn to understand and respect the differences and similarities between people. A letter will be sent home to parents with more information regarding this.
