Curriculum Information

English

We will be looking at the book Alice in Wonder Land. We will be looking at the characters and the setting within the book before creating our own chapter.

Maths

We will be learning to read, write and count to 1000. Multiplication 1 digit by 2-digit numbers. With and without exchanging. Multiplication 2 digit and 2-digit numbers.

Science

We will be looking at a range of plants. Tong Garden Centre will be visiting to discuss with the children the importance of plants and how we look after them.

Humanities

In geography we will be locating Egypt and learning about their culture, climate and settlements.

Art / Design Technology

In DT we will be tasting, designing, making and evaluating sandwiches. In art, we will be learning about the famous artist Quentin Blake.

PE

In PE we will be learning an Egyptian dance and preforming this to other classes within school. We will also be using tennis rackets for support with control.

Computing

We will be learning to use technology safely, respectfully, and responsibly; recognise acceptable / unacceptable behaviour

Other

In languages, we will be learning Year 3 vocabulary numbers, greetings, names and places. In PSHE, we will be looking at drugs and medicines and how they can be harmful.
