Curriculum Information

English

In Writing, we will be looking at how to use different pieces of grammar such as relative clauses and modal verbs to indicate degrees of possibility. This will help improve our Writing and sentence structure. We will also be learning the play 'Macbeth' ready to perform the play in front of parents and children from other schools at the Carriageworks theatre.

Maths

In maths, we will be developing our understanding of much larger numbers, including looking at squared and cubed numbers. We will continue to revisit all of our times tables following on from completion of our times tables check in Year 4. We will also be using our developing fluency skills to complete multi-step problem solving and reasoning questions.

Science

In Science, we will continue to work on developing our understanding of properties of materials and changes.

Humanities

In Humanities, we will build upon our work in Key Stage 1 by looking at the continent of Europe in further detail. We will learn geographical language such as longitude and latitude, as well as comparing scientific and geographic data from 5 different countries in Europe. We will use this data to make reasoned interpretations about what life might be like in these countries and triangulate this with other information available to us, such as videos and photographs of places that we can visit. We will compare some data with local data to support children's contextual understanding.

Art / Design Technology

In DT, we will be looking at how Vikings built their homes and making our own mini wattle and daub buildings using natural materials. We will also learn how to understand a design brief with a clear intention and goal. We will understand how to plan and how to make our design, as well as evaluating our finished product against the original design specification.

PE

In outdoor PE, we will learn how to play tag rugby. This will involve teaching children how to pass and receive the ball, as well as making different movements, such as evasion and sprinting (with the ball in hand). Our indoor PE this term will be gymnastics, children will develop their accuracy, consistency and clarity of movement. They will work with apparatus and vary their compositional ideas.

Computing

In Computing, we will continue to learn about e-safety and online safety. We will use different software to use spreadsheets that can calculate formulas for different purposes.

Other

In Music, we will use Charanga Music scheme to develop our Musical understanding, as well as continuing to learn the ukulele. In Spanish, we will be learning the language associated with being at home. In PSHE, we will be learning about keeping safe.
