## Curriculum Information

### English

In English, children will be developing their reading repertoire by reading *Wuthering Heights* and developing their Writing skills by using authorial bias. We will look at how authors use specific vocabulary to create an image and develop our composition. Children will also enjoy Writing their own narrative based on the short horror film, *Frances Brandywine*.

### Maths

Over the coming weeks, children will learn how to use formal written methods to complete long and short division. After we will move onto fractions- looking at how we calculate equivalent fractions, convert improper fractions to mixed numbers fractions, add and subtract fractions, and even multiply and divide by an integer.

### Science

In Science, we will learn to group and classify organisms according to their characteristics. We will be finding out about Carl Linnaeus and his classification system and we'll explore what micro-organisms are and how they can be grouped.

### Humanities

In our Geography, we will be consolidating our understanding of the wider world, looking at the process of globalisation and how countries that have experienced an Industrial revolution have developed in comparison to those that haven't. We will contrast and compare the difference between the global north and the global south.

### Art / Design Technology

In DT, we will learn all about the production of bread; including how it has originated and the different forms it has taken across the globe. Children will have to opportunity to do bread tasting and eventually design and make their own loaf from a design brief.

### PE

In outdoor PE, we will be building our football skills, developing our ability to work as a team to defend and attack as well as scoring powerful penalties.

### Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about coding. We will make our own games with timers and scores using variables. We will also use functions in our programming.

### Other

In Music, we will be developing our skills in playing the ukulele as well as developing melodic phrases and understanding structure & form.
