


Westerr Sahara

Date	Significant Event	afterlife	A life that some people believe begins when you die, for example a life in heaven or as another
3100 BC	Early settlers arrive in the Nile Valley	amulet	person or animal A charm that Egyptians believed brought
1400 BC	Tutankhamen becomes Pharaoh of Egypt	ancient	protection from disease Meaning something that is really old
30 BC	Egypt becomes part of the Roman Empire	archaeologist	Someone who studies the past by exploring old remains
AD 1922	Archaeologist, Howard Carter, discovers the tomb of Tutankhamen	artefacts	An object from the past that shows evidence of what life was like
