Maud Lewis Folk Art – Maud Lewis was a Canadian artist.

These are examples of her coastal art:



Backgrounds should be left to dry before painting foregrounds.

You can paint on top of paint and this is called layering.

Collage can be added to paintings.

Red and blue make purple.

Red and yellow make orange.

Blue and yellow make purple.

Adding white to a paint makes the colour lighter.

These are examples of paintings that we might create.

thin (paint)	Runny
draw	Produce a picture by making marks
sketch	A quick drawing
design	A plan of an idea
create	Make something
paint	Coloured liquid used for creating pictures
texture	Look or feel of a surface, eg smooth, rough
pattern	A decorative design
foreground	Part of the picture nearest to the front. Can appear larger.
background	Part of the picture furthest from the viewer.
collage	A picture made by sticking materials onto paper.
print	Press marks onto a surface to make designs
