

Topic: Stone Age to Iron Age Jewellery and Clothes Year 4

What I should already know

- I can cut, roll and coil material like playdough or clay.

Key Knowledge

Stone Age **jewellery** included beads on necklaces and bracelets, pendants and hair pins. They made these beads from shells, animal teeth, animal bones or **stones**. They would then thread these beads onto string often made from plant stems or thin strips of animal hide

Clay can be manipulated to create these shapes.

In later **Stone Age** times, **clothes** were made from grasses and plant stems that were woven together to make fabric. Animal hides were also worn, and were especially useful in cold weather

Stone Age people used natural dyes like nut shells, berries and flowers to dye the fabric they made.

Vocabulary

draw	To use a pen or pencil to make a picture
sketch	To draw something quickly and roughly
design	A drawing from which something can be built or made
texture	The way something feels when you touch it
pattern	A drawing that can be copied to make something else, such as clothes
sculpture	A work of art made by shaping or carving
3D	A shape with three dimensions such as width, height and depth
fabric	Cloth
stitch	To use a needle and thread to sew material together
form	To make or give a particular shape
