Curriculum Information

English

We will be learning the following new sounds in phonics: ay, oy, ea, ie, ow, ew, ou, ir, aw, eer, are, ce, ea, ed. We will then be focusing on reading and spelling words with these sounds in. When writing, we will be looking at stories and poems, focusing on using finger spaces between words, full stops and capital letters when writing.

Maths

We will be focusing on addition and subtraction, including problem solving. We will also be extending knowledge of place value with numbers up to 20.

Science

We will begin to look at how things change during the different seasons, we will link this to the weather.

Humanities

In history, we will be continuing to learn about castles, including a visit to Skipton castle on Thursday November 7th. We will be looking at family history and how they have changed since they were a baby and how things have changed since their grandparents were their age. In geography we will be learning the names of the continents.

Art / Design Technology

In DT we will be investigating, designing and making wheeled vehicles.

PE

We will be learning basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. We will also be focusing on dance.

Computing

In computing we will be looking at internet safety and exploring Purple Mash.

Other

In music, we will be exploring pulse, pitch and rhythm. The children will listen and respond to some medieval music linked to our castles topic and will learn a castles

song. In, RE, we will be looking at special stories, beginning with stories special to each individual pupil and then beginning to look at special religious stories such as the Bible and Quran. In PSHE, we will learn about keeping safe and managing risk. The children will identify people who they can go to for help. Our Mind Mate lesson will focus on identifying when they themselves and others are feeling happy and the effect that this has on others.
