Curriculum Information

English

In writing, we will be continuing to learn about different elements of grammar that will improve our writing, including fronted adverbials of time, place, and cause. We will also be looking at the use of 'a/an' for nouns, and how to use speech marks to denote dialogue. We will be looking at different books including Stone Age Boy and The Firework Maker's Daughter.

Maths

In maths, we will continue to develop our fluency skills with numbers up to 1000. We will apply this to various number problems as well as reasoning questions. Children will also continue to develop their mathematical knowledge of various timetables, building on their knowledge of 2s, 5s, and 10s from Year 2 and moving into 3s, 4s, and 8s.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at different types of rocks and learning new vocabulary. (sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic) we will also be Investigating soils and researching the famous Mary Anning the first archaeologist.

Humanities

In Humanities, we will be looking at geography. In particular, we will be looking at different types of settlements, including the stone age settlement of Skara Brae. We will then take a journey through time to look at how modern settlements and land are used.

Art / Design Technology

In Art, we will be drawing still life of humans and plants. As well as, understanding the process of being an artist. We will Explain how we will make our own still life pieces using plants. We will practise drawing, look at tone and composition.

PE

In PE, we will be learning about the sport 'Handball'. We will learn how to throw and catch balls, as well as dodge and evade them. This will teach us about how to play a game with simple rules. In outdoor PE, we will be learning how to play football, including some simple passing and moving strategies.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about online safety. As well as this, we will

be looking at how to make simple spreadsheets in order to calculate simple, mathematical equations.

Other

In Music, we will use the Charanga music scheme, as well as continuing to learn the recorder. In PSHE, we will be learning about bullying, and how to keep safe from bullies. We will also learn how to report bullying if we think that we have witnessed it.
