## Curriculum Information

### English

In English we will be looking at poetry, a creative nonchronological report about dragons and a time-slip story (based on the novel The Killing Ground).

### Maths

In maths this term we are doing multiplication and fractions. We are following the White Rose Maths scheme of work.

### Science

We are looking at materials and their properties and will be doing experiments on separating materials and irreversible changes.

### Humanities

We will be learning about the different countries that make up Europe and comparing the different ways of life in some European countries. They will look at statistical, geographical data to find different ways to compare and contrast life in Europe.

### Art / Design Technology

In DT, children will be doing a cooking & nutrition unit, in which they will make Raisin and Banana Cookies.

### PE

In PE, we will be doing Tag rugby and fitness. We will also continue organised football sessions during our breaktimes.

### Computing

In computing, we will be learning all about online safety and scratch.

### Other

In music, children will be learning to play the ukulele and get started with Music Tech learning. In Spanish the children are learning about the language of 'my house'. In PSHE, we will be continuing our weekly drama/group sessions, focusing on the topics of being safe, healthy relationships and friendships. The children will also start to
