## Curriculum Information



### English

Through studying the book, *The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe*, children will be predicting what is behind the wardrobe. They will be writing character and setting descriptions, story mapping, and writing their own adventure stories.



### Maths

In maths, we will be learning about money, recognising coins, counting values and solving problems. We will then move onto multiplication and division and begin to learn out 2s, 5s and 10s multiplication tables.



### Science

In science, we will learn about the life cycle of animals, their basic needs, and the importance of food and exercise.



### Humanities

In geography, our topic for this half term is the Arctic. Children will learn about the hot and cold regions of the world and look in detail at the people and wildlife of the Arctic Circle. Using this knowledge, children will compare an Arctic settlement with one in the UK.



### Art / Design Technology

In DT, children will make and evaluate couscous.



### PE

In PE we will be learning about how to develop balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities. We will perform dances using simple movement patterns.



### Other

In computing, we will be looking at Algorithms Coding. Understand what algorithms are, how they are implemented as programs on digital devices, and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions. In music, we will be learning about how music can shape our way of life. We will learn about high/low pitch, loud/quiet dynamics and learn, sing and compose. In RE, we will be retelling stories about religious and non-religious rules, suggesting

some meanings. Children will find out about and give examples of different religious rules and begin to express ideas about what makes a good rule and why these are important in helping people to live together co-operatively. Children will also look at the Lunar New Year. In PSHE we will be learning about celebrating difference.
