- your baby's attachment to you will pave the way for their future

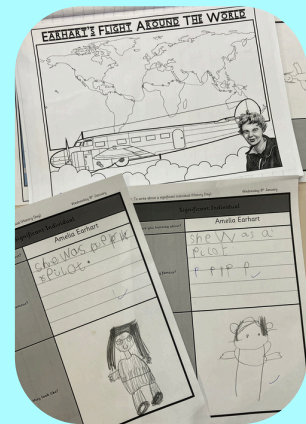
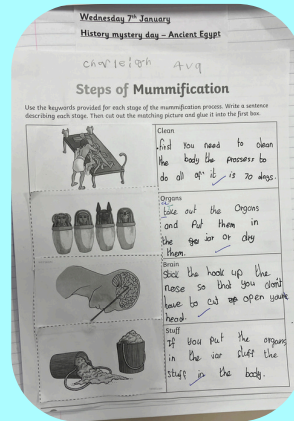
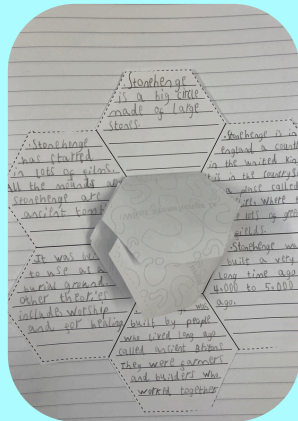
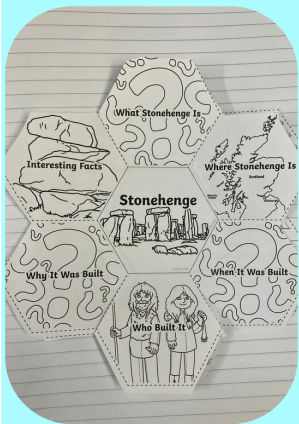
