Curriculum Information



English

In English we will be learning about alternative spellings patterns and reading and spelling words with these patterns. We will be writing recounts, letters and stories linked to our class book 'The man on the moon'.



Maths

In maths, we will continue to learn about fractions. This includes finding halves, quarters and thirds of shapes and numbers. We will learn that 2 quarters is the same as 2 halves.



Science

In science, we will be learning about plants. We will observe seeds and bulbs and watch them grow. Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.



Humanities



In history, we will be learning about who Ernest Shackleton was and what he did, as well as discussing what life was like between 1907 and 1917.
