Curriculum Information



English

Children will build their writing stamina in preparation for secondary school, using a broad range of grammatical structures, and ambitious vocabulary. We will continue to develop our understanding of different genres and what features need to be included in each. Children will have the opportunity to read a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts and become more confident in answering longer test style questions about authorial intent.



Maths

Children will revise the 4 operations and place value work that they have learned so far in preparation for their maths SAT's while also consolidating their understanding of area and perimeter, data handling, conversions between units and geometry.



Science

Children will develop their understanding of electricity, building on previous learning, and be able to identify and label all different aspects of an electrical circuit, build one and then comment on how and why specific materials conduct or insulate electricity.



Humanities

The children will continue to learn about the devastating effect of climate change on our planet, in addition to how it is caused and what we can do to limit if not reverse the carbon emissions we release into the atmosphere



Art / Design Technology

Art, DT and music will all be combined as the children rehearse, develop, design and choreograph their own Year 6 leavers production throughout the summer term. This will include learning lines, performing, singing, dancing and set and costume design in addition to organising the logistics, designing the posters, producing the tickets and using this performance as a way to fundraise for their final leavers assembly and leavers disco!



PE

We will be enjoying the warmer weather and practicing for sports day by

developing our athletic skills, in particular building our overall fitness and stamina through weekly timed runs.

Other

Children will learn about what Christians believe about the death of Jesus and the significance of his resurrection including how it is celebrated each year at Easter.
