Curriculum Information

Communication and Language

We will be reading stories and information books about the seaside, the ocean and Africa. Children will be encouraged to join in with the stories and talk about them using simple sentences. Our new role play areas will be an ice cream parlour, a beach, and a cafe.

Physical Development

We will be threading to developing our fine and gross motor skills. We will choreograph a simple pirate dance. The children will move in different ways such as walking the plank, sailing the boat, digging for treasure, swimming or looking out to sea like a pirate.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Phonics

We will focus on phase one phonics, aspects 5, 6, and 7 to support our understanding of alliteration, using some of the level one Floppy phonics sounds for the activities. We will use our voices to create sounds and learn how to blend the sounds that adults say into words.

Literacy

We will encourage children to share their experiences of visiting the seaside. We will read the story 'Sharing a Shell' and talk about the importance of sharing with our friends. We will also be talking about transition, for children who will be starting school in September.

Maths

We will continue singing number songs. We will be counting out objects to match numerals ensuring that we count every object. We will describe patterns and identify errors, then we will create our own patterns. We will match, sort and compare objects in different ways.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring floating and sinking. We will develop the children's knowledge about animals, including those that live at the seaside and in Africa. We will explore similarities and differences between themselves and others. We will use simple maps.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will provide a variety of materials for children to use to build boats and investigate how to make them float on the water. We will also create a large-scale under the sea picture using paint and collage materials.
