## Curriculum Information



### English

In English, we will be focusing our writing about the book the Iron Man. We will be revising key grammar skills and writing our own newspaper reports. We will also write our own Science Fiction Monster stories based on the Iron Man.



### Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about money, time and we will also be learning about angles and 3D shapes. We will continue to revise our knowledge and understanding of the four operations and practise our rapid recall of times tables facts.



### Science

In Science, we will continue to learn about animals including humans. We will learn about the importance of nutrition and how humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.



### Humanities

In Geography, we will be learning about Ancient Greece, and we will develop our understanding of the human and physical geography of a European city. We will learn what Greece is like now and use different types of maps to identify and label different features.



### Art / Design Technology

In DT we will be designing and making a traditional Greek tunic. We will use research and develop a design criteria to inform the design of innovative and functional products that are fit for purpose. We will also generate, develop and communicate our ideas through discussion and annotated sketches before creating our final product.



### PE

In PE, we will be learning how play badminton, we will focus on identifying and describing the rules of badminton, serve to begin a game and explore forehand hitting. We will also be doing athletics, and we will practise different events such as sprinting, relay and javelin in readiness for sports day.



### Computing

In computing, we will be learning how to present using Microsoft PowerPoint. We will learn how to make a presentation, add media, animations and timing. We will then create our own presentations and present these to the class.



### Other

In music, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. We will also learn about musical styles, with a focus on folk music, and we will try to recognise different sounds. In Spanish, we will learn 10 common shapes and also the numbers 1-5 in Spanish. By the end of the unit we will be able to recognise, recall, remember and spell up to 10 shape nouns with their indefinite articles/determiners in the foreign language. In RE, we will be looking at the various ways that religions use different art forms to express their spirituality and beliefs. In PSHE, we will continue to learn how to deal with put downs and learn about positive ways to deal with setbacks. We will also cover Relationship and Sex Education and the unit of work will focus on learning to understand the similarities and differences between people.
