Curriculum Information



English

In writing, we will be covering the following text types: non-chronological report & a scary story. In reading, we will look at the following text: Beowulf



Maths

In maths, we will be continuing with decimals. We will also cover time and position/direction. We will continue to work on the 4 operations in arithmetic sessions, and we will complete the multiplication check in June.



Science

In science, we will be learning about teeth and the digestive system. We will learn the names of the organs that make up the digestive system and complete some investigations.



Humanities

In geography, we will be focusing on plate tectonics, volcanoes and mountains. We will continue our lessons about the Anglo-Saxons in history. We will also be orienteering in Bramley Park.



Art / Design Technology

In art, we will be focusing on sketching and watercolour painting. We will practise using watercolour paints and then create a watercolour painting of Bramley Fall Woods. In DT, we will create buzzer toys with electrical circuits.



PE

In PE, we will continue with our Friday swimming sessions. We will also be focusing on the skills needed for athletics.



Computing

In computing, we will be looking at and creating audio books.



Other

In music, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. We will also use Charanga to support our learning. We will listen to, discuss, improvise, compose and perform musical pieces. In Spanish, we will continue to build on

the vocabulary that we have already learnt by learning some Spanish verbs and conjunctions. In PSHE, we will be looking at food choices, role models and similarities/differences. The MindMate lesson will be about coping in difficult situations.
