Curriculum Information



English

In English, we will be recapping sounds taught in Year 1 and focusing on spelling words with these sounds. We will be practising handwriting and using full stops and capital letters consistently.



Maths

In maths, we will be learning to read, write and count to 100. We will be looking at tens and ones within numbers to 100. We will also be learning to add and subtract within 100 and practising number bonds to and within 10 and 20.



Science

In science, we will be looking at different types of materials, their properties and how they change. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.



Humanities

Our topic for this half term is London. We will look at the difference between a village, city, country and continent, as well as remembering the other capital cities in the UK.



Art / Design Technology

In art, we will be learning about famous London landmarks. Children will build on previous drawing experience of creating tone and texture. They will develop this by experimenting with new mediums – charcoal and ink and developing mark making techniques in these areas.



PE

In PE, we will be learning basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. We will be participating in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.



Computing

In computing, we will be coding using Purple Mash.

Other

In music, we will be learning about how music can shape our way of life. We will learn



about high/low pitch, loud/quiet dynamics and learn, sing and compose. In RE, we will learn why books and stories are special by looking at our favourite books and how they are treated. Stories from the Bible and the Qu'ran. What are the morals and the meanings of the stories? In PSHE, we will be learning about what a healthy diet looks like and knowing the benefits of a healthy diet (including oral health).
