# **Curriculum Information**

# Literacy, including Communication and Language

This half term we will be reading the following books; Teeny Weeny Tadpole; The Very Hungry Caterpillar; Mad about minibeasts; Rumble in the Jungle; Squash and a Squeeze; Cautious Caterpillar. We will be looking at unfamiliar vocabulary, discussing the meaning and finding the key words in the text. We will also be retelling stories, ordering key events and writing in various different formats e.g. speech bubbles, storyboards and animal fact files.

#### **Phonics**

We will be learning the new pieces of code as follows; ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air and er. Our new helpful words will be; be, are, my, sister, too. We will continue to use our phonics knowledge and apply it to reading and writing simple sentences.

#### Maths

We will be focusing on numbers 15-20, representing them in different ways. We will be looking at patterns including repeating patterns and more complex patterns. Continuing our work on addition and subtraction, number bonds to 10 and recalling doubling and halving facts.

#### **PSHE**

Key themes we will explore and discuss are; holidays, special places, keeping things safe and keeping yourself safe.

# **Understanding the World**

This half term we will be focusing on Animals. We will be learning about animals and their habitats. Where in the world different animals live and locating their habitat on a map. We will also be looking at animal life cycles, including those of a frog and butterfly.

# **Expressive Arts and Design**

This half term we will be creating models using recycled materials, using a variety of tools and techniques to print and independently colour mix for a purpose. We will also be creating 3D sculptures using clay and air dough. Our focus artist will be Andy Warhol. In music, children will move in time to the music, create their own songs and dances to go with.
