Curriculum Information

English

We will be recapping the phonics code that we have covered, in preparation for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check (12th to 16th June). We will also be reading 'The Snail and the Whale'. We will develop writing narratives and create non-chronological reports about plants.

Maths

In maths we will be measuring mass and volume. We will also learn to recognise and count coins. We will be extending knowledge of place value up to 100 and introduce position and direction.

Science

In science, we will be consolidating our work on plants by planting seeds and observing them growing recording what we find out in a diary. We will continue looking at describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

Humanities

Our work this half term will focus on the topic of 'Seaside.' In history, we will be looking at Grace Darling and her links to the seaside. In geography, we will continue to look at differences/similarities between Leeds and Scarborough including physical and human features. We will be visiting Scarborough and the RNLI centre.

Art / Design Technology

In art, we will be looking at the work of Maud Lewis and producing paintings in a similar style of the seaside.

PE

In outdoor P.E. we will be learning basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. In indoor P.E. we will be developing performing gymnastics actions and shapes at the same time or one person after another and to turn and jump quarter and half turns.

Computing

The children will be using 'maze explorers' for coding using directions.

Other

In music we will be learning songs about familiar daily routines using the following skills; listening, singing, playing, composing and performing. PSHE will focus on money with a focus on how we earn it and whether to spend it or save it.
