Curriculum Information

English

In reading, we will be looking at fiction, non-fiction and poems about volcanoes, earthquakes and space. In English we are extending a story using dialogue and an information text. We are also going to be writing a non-chronological report and a diary.

Maths

Decimals – Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of decimal numbers. Properties of shape – measuring and calculating angles, triangles and quadrilaterals, regular and irregular polygons. Position and Direction – translation, symmetry and grid coordinates.

Science

Children will be learning about Space including planets, night and day and the movement of the moon.

Humanities

In geography we will be looking at earthquakes, volcanoes, tsunamis and tornadoes. We will also be looking at the different layers of the Earth and how this can lead to extreme conditions.

Art / Design Technology

In art we will be continuing our project on creating prints based on Climate Change.

PE

Indoor PE will be gymnastics. Outdoor PE will be athletics.

Other

We will be looking at how our bodies change during puberty, as well as relationships and emotions as part of our RSE education lessons. As part of our work on the coronation we will be looking at urbanisation and Poundbury.
