# **Curriculum Information**

### English

For writing, through our Great Fire of London topic, we will be writing diary entries, newspaper reports, instructions and recounts. We will learn about different sentence types and adding common suffixes to words.

#### Maths

In Maths we are going to be looking at Money. Children will compare values in pounds and pence, find totals of different amounts and work out change.

#### Science

We will continue to look at materials. We will look at different types of materials, their properties and how they change. The children will find out how the shapes of solid objects can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. (linked to our Great fire of London topic)

#### **Humanities**

Our topic for this half term is Great fire of London. We will look at range of historical sources, including artefacts [leather bucket, Fireman's hat] and accounts [Samuel Pepys' diary]. The children will also complete a 'London's Burning' workshop where they will make houses, and then re-create the Great Fire.

#### Art / Design Technology

Our D.T topic is Cooking & Nutrition. We will look at recipes, ingredients and making biscuits.

#### PE

In P.E we will explore space, direction, levels and speeds. Experiment creating actions and performing movements with different body parts.

#### Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at grouping, as well as how to keep safe when online.

#### Other

In Music, we will be learning about how music can shape our way of life. We will learn about high/low pitch, loud/quiet dynamics and learn, sing and compose. In RE, our topic is Christianity, where we will answer the question: "How is new life welcomed?" We will also look at Christmas and the nativity. In PSHE, we will be learning about our Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing.
