Curriculum Information

English

In Writing, we will be continuing to learn about different elements of grammar that will improve our Writing, including fronted adverbials of time, place, and cause. We will also be looking at the use of 'a/an' for nouns, and how to use speech marks to denote dialogue. We will be looking at different books including Stone Age Boy and The Firework Maker's Daughter.

Maths

In maths, we will continue to develop our fluency skills with numbers up to 1000. We will apply this to various number problems as well as reasoning questions. Children will also continue to develop their mathematical knowledge of various timetables, building on their knowledge of 2s, 5s, and 10s from Year 2 and moving into 3s, 4s, and 8s.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at light and how it creates shadows of different shapes and sizes. We will learn about different types of objects, including opaque, translucent, and transparent ones. We will also learn about the eye and how it takes in light, and how this then travels to our brain to allow us to see.

Humanities

In Humanities, we will be looking at Geography. In particular, we will be looking at different types of settlements, including the stone age settlement of Skara Brae. We will then take a journey through time to look at how modern settlements and land are used.

Art / Design Technology

In Design Technology, we will be learning simple techniques to build mini version of Stone Age houses. We will look at different ways of joining specific materials. We will also learn how to understand a design brief with a clear intention and goal. We will understand how to plan and how to make our design, as well as evaluating our finished product against the original design specification.

PE

In PE, we will be learning about the sport 'Handball'. We will learn how to throw and catch balls, as well as dodge and evade them. This will teach us about how to play a game with simple rules. In outdoor PE, we will be learning how to play football, including some simple passing and moving strategies.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about online safety. As well as this, we will be looking at how to make simple spreadsheets in order to calculate simple, mathematical equations.

Other

In Music, we will use the Charanga Music scheme, as well as continuing to learn the recorder. In PSHE, we will be learning about bullying, and how to keep safe from bullies. We will also learn how to report bullying if we think that we have witnessed it.
