


	<p>Fish</p>  <p>shark salmon goldfish</p> <p>Amphibians</p>  <p>Frog toad newt</p>	<p>Birds</p>	<p>An animal with feathers, wings and a beak that is usually able to fly. They lay eggs.</p>
		<p>Mammals</p>	<p>An animal that feeds its young with milk from the mother and has skin usually more or less covered with hair.</p>
		<p>Pet</p>	<p>A friendly animal trained to live with humans.</p>
		<p>Carnivore</p>	<p>An animal that feeds on other animals.</p>
		<p>Herbivore</p>	<p>An animal that feeds on plants.</p>
		<p>Omnivore</p>	<p>An animal or person that eats a variety of food of both plant and animal origin.</p>
