### **Curriculum Information**

# **English**

In English we will be learning about alternative spellings patterns and reading and spelling words with these patterns. We will be writing recounts, letters and stories linked to our class book.

#### **Maths**

In Maths we will continue to learn about fractions, including 1/3 and 1/4. We will begin to learn about measures.

#### **Science**

In science we will be learning about plants. We will observe seeds and bulbs and watch them grow. Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

#### **Humanities**

In history we will be learning about Neil Armstrong and the moon landing.

# **Art / Design Technology**
