Curriculum Information

English

In writing, we will be covering the following text types: crime narrative, non-chronological report and poetry. In reading, we will look at the following texts: Charlotte's Web, Anglo-Saxons (non-fiction) and the song Penny Lane.

Maths

In maths, we will be covering measurement and decimals. We will continue to work on the 4 operations in arithmetic sessions, with a strong focus on times tables to ensure children are prepared for the multiplication check in June.

Science

In science, we will be sorting living things in different ways. We will also look at the animal groups: mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish. We will also use classification keys and look at the local wildlife.

Humanities

In geography, we will continue learning about Mexico. In history, we will be focusing on the Anglo-Saxons. We will learn about where they came from and about their daily lives/society. We will also look at what happened in 1066.

Art / Design Technology

In art, we will be focusing on sketching and watercolour painting. We will practise using watercolour paints and then create a watercolour painting of Bramley Fall Woods. In DT, We will create vases out of clay.

PE

In PE, we will continue with our Friday swimming sessions. We will also be focusing on the skills needed to play tag rugby.

Computing

In computing, we will use Purplemash to focus on animations. We will use backgrounds, pictures and drawing tools to create the animations. We will also look at effective searching.

Other

In RE, we will be looking at the Sikh religion. We will learn about Guru Nanak and his significance in Sikhism. We will also compare and contrast Guru Nanak to other important figures. In PSHE, we will be working on mental health and wellbeing, as well as focusing on dealing with the feelings associated with loss. The MindMate lesson will be about being the same and being different.
