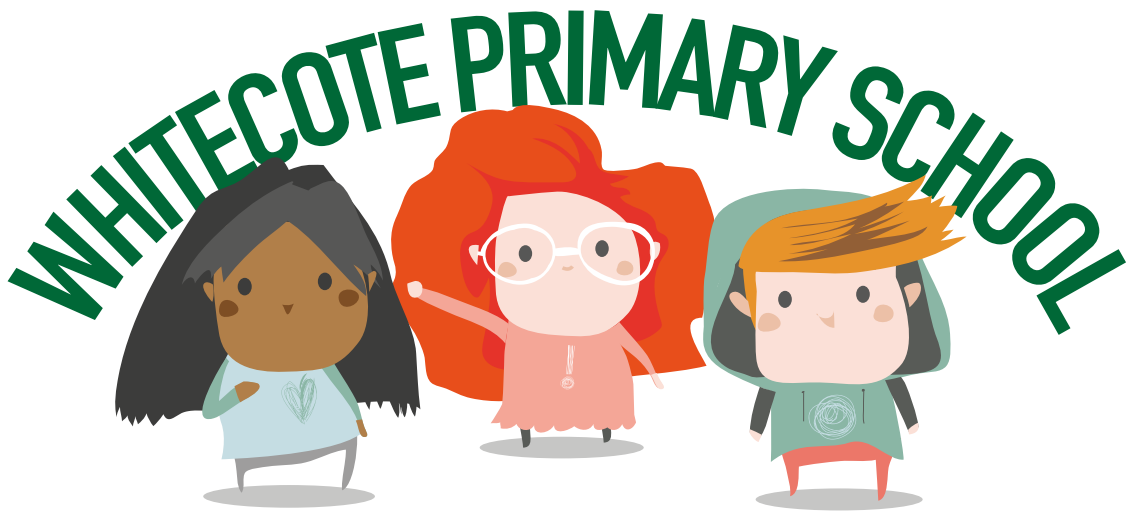

Our School Aims and Values

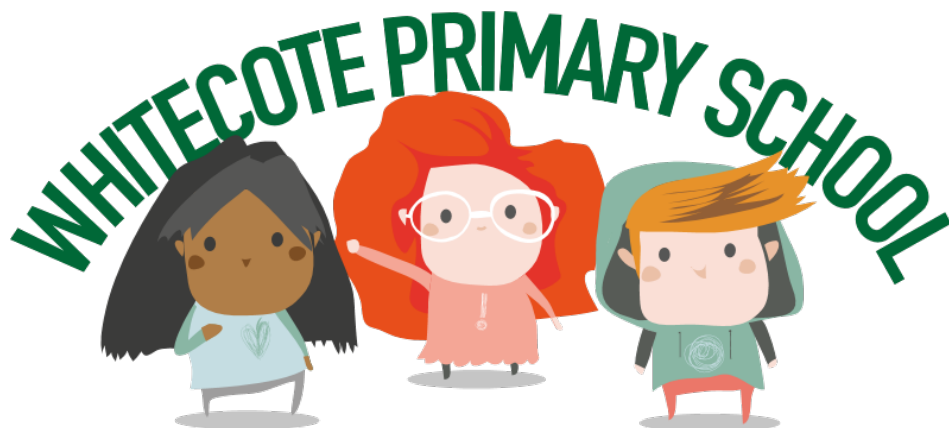
Our three school core values are:

Some of the main things that we will be learning this year are:



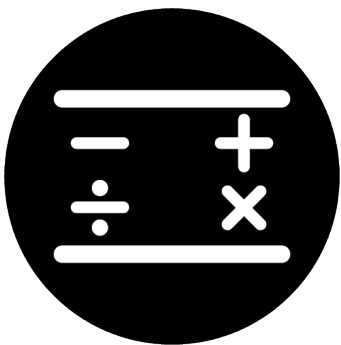
Writing

Children will begin their writing journey by making lots of different marks in the environment, such as painting, drawing, and writing. We will also help develop children's fine motor skills.



Phonics and Reading

Much of our phonics in Little Doves will be based on making sounds with our voices and identifying the different sounds in words. When children are ready, they will learn to say the different sounds they can hear in words.



Numeracy

Early counting will be a particular focus for children in Nursery. We will sing lots of different nursery rhymes and number rhymes to support this.

Understanding the World

Our past and present curriculum offers children the chance to experience first-hand history. Children will learn about the important people in their family.

Children will read lots of stories from different places around the world which will help them understand about the many different types of locations and cultures as part of our people, cultures and communities.

We will begin to learn about the people who are important to us inside and outside of school.



Expressive Arts and Design

Children in Little Doves will experiment with lots of different colours and techniques, as well as making different marks with different materials.

Children will learn how to hold different tools such as pencils and scissors. They will begin to use these in their learning.

Singing songs will be a huge part of our Little Doves curriculum this year. This will help with our language development and numerical understanding. Musically, children will learn how to sing using louder and quieter voices.
