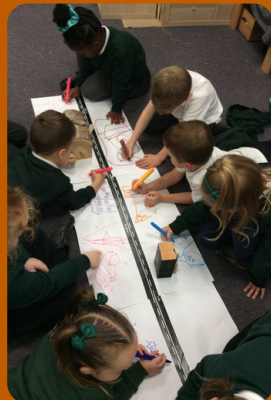
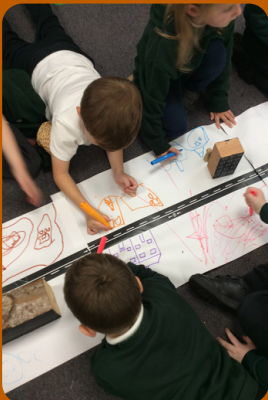
# Year 5 - Murton Park
