If there are any items left to sell, parents will be notified by text, and they will be available outside the hall doors on the top playground (weather permitting or the hall if the weather is bad) at the end of the school day.

The Student Council would like to raise as much money as possible for Children in Need so they would also like the children to wear brightly coloured clothes on Friday 15th November, including a silly hairstyle, to help make this a fun day. In return, they would like to ask for a donation of £1, which you will be able to bring in cash on the day or add to our fundraising page for this event.
