Breathe easy homes



The Breathe Easy Homes service addresses issues with indoor air quality in the home, which can trigger attacks for children who have a diagnosis of asthma or other respiratory conditions e.g. viral wheeze.

Housing/indoor air quality factors include cold, damp, mould, condensation and allergens such as dust mites and pet dander.

A referral to Breathe Easy Homes allows families who meet the eligibility criteria to access advice, support and equipment to reduce asthma triggers in their home.

PLEASE NOTE:

Referrals are accepted from primary and secondary care or external agencies working with the families.

Self-referrals are not accepted.

Eligibility Criteria

- To be referred a family must include a child aged 0-18 who has diagnosed respiratory issues which are triggered by home indoor air quality.
- a household income of £30,000
- savings of less than £16,000

Breathe Easy Homes is delivered by Care & Repair Leeds, in partnership with Leeds City Council and the Integrated Care Boards (ICB) in Leeds.

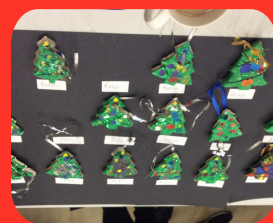
