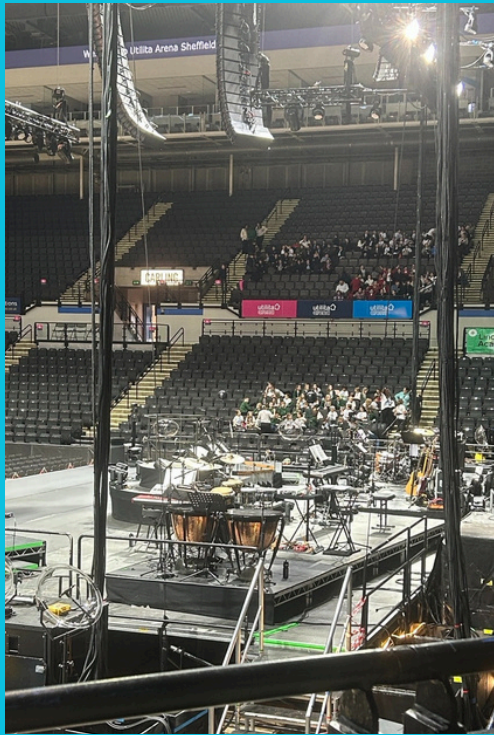

NHS Pharmacy First Service

The NHS-funded service enables children and adults to get convenient access to advice and treatment where appropriate for seven common conditions, without having to wait for a GP appointment. There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Boots pharmacy with their child and ask for help.

The service supports with the following conditions for people in the age groups specified below: Ear ache (aged 1 to 17 years), Impetigo (aged 1 year and over), Infected insect bites and stings (aged 1 year and over), Sore throats (aged 5 years and over), Sinusitis (aged 12 years and over), Uncomplicated urinary tract infections (UTIs) in women (aged 16 to 64 years), Shingles (aged 18 years and over)

The person will see a pharmacist in a private consultation room. The pharmacist will provide advice and, if clinically appropriate, offer to supply treatment for the condition*. If treatment is provided, an electronic message will be sent to the person's GP surgery so their health record can be updated.

UNDER 5

Every child under the age of five is entitled to free school milk. Simply register your child online.



Child
OVER 5

Every child over the age of five is entitled to milk at a subsidised cost of around £20 per term. Register your child and pay online.

Children in receipt of benefits-based free school meals are eligible for free school milk. Speak to the school for further information.

Free milk for under 5s is funded by the Department of Health and milk for over 5s is subsidised by DEFRA.
