## Curriculum Information

### English

In English, we will begin by rewriting the Witches' incantation speech from Act 4 Scene 1 and then return to work on The Secret Garden, creating narrative pieces to creatively predict the ending of The Secret Garden.

### Maths

We are going to be focusing on fractions (adding, subtracting, ordering and comparing) this half term, as well as weekly arithmetic sessions.

### Science

In science, we will be continuing our learning about animals including humans. This topic looks at human and animal lifecycles.

### Humanities

In geography, we will be exploring the country of India through mapwork and comparison to our own locality in Bramley.

### Art / Design Technology

In DT, we will be exploring construction and mechanical systems with specific focus on flags and drawbridges.

### PE

In indoor PE, we will be developing our dance practice with a focus on superheroes. In outdoor PE, we will be developing our tennis skills, building up to taking part in a game of tennis with our peers.

### Computing

In computing, we will be learning how to use and create a database on the website 2Investigate.

### Other

In music, there will be a focus on Kings and Queen, linking to our history topic. We will be continuing to develop our skills on the ukulele. In Spanish, we will be learning how to say, use and write words relating to sports and hobbies. In PSHE, we will be learning about Identity, Society and Equality: Stereotypes, Discrimination, Prejudice

and Homophobia.
