**5 ELM** - Nkanyiso M - You have been asking questions to improve on your comprehension.

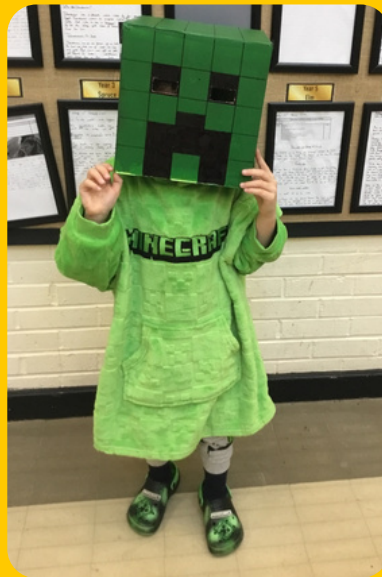
**6 CEDAR** - Harry B - You know what you need to work on and are developing perseverance.
