There will be a change of cost for school meals, effective next week. Leeds City Council, our meal provider, has increased their price per meal to £2.75.

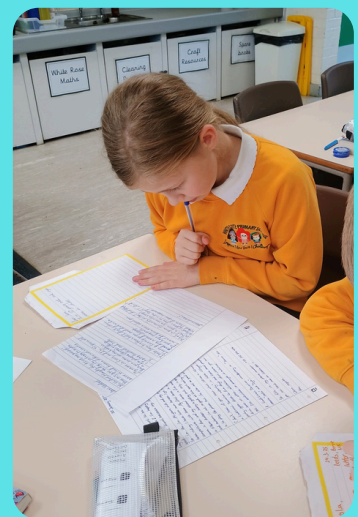
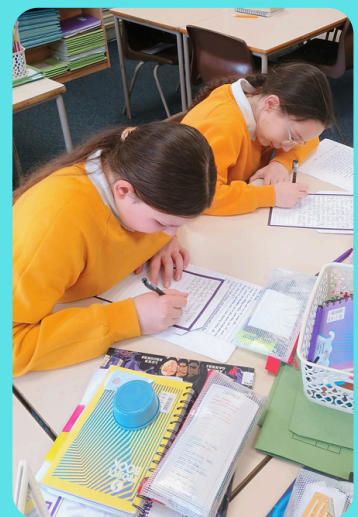
we have decided to subsidise the cost, and the price of a school meal will be **£2.50 per child, per day.**
