Inspire Nurture Challenge

Curriculum Information

Communication and Language

Children are encouraged to talk in full sentences, answer questions and talk in detail about their responses. They will be able to follow a story without pictures or prompts, discuss what they have heard and make predictions about what may happen next.

Physical Development

In PE we will be focusing on sports day practise which will include practising; running, relay, obstacle and egg & spoon races.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Circle Time children will be working on self-development, how to manage changes and transitions and the feelings associated with these topics.

Phonics

In Phonics we will be recapping all of the codes we have learnt so far and learning the new pieces of code; igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, er

Literacy

In Literacy we will be looking at Teeny Weeny Tadpole, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Mad about minibeasts, Rumble in the Jungle, Squash and a Squeeze & The Cautious Caterpillar. We will be looking at unfamiliar vocabulary, discussing the meaning and finding the key words in the text. We will also be retelling stories, ordering key events and writing for different purposes e.g. speech bubbles, storyboards and animal fact files.

Maths

In Maths we will be recapping and consolidating; Odd & Even numbers, Doubling, Addition & Subtraction and Number bonds to 5. We will look in detail at numbers to 20 and learn number bonds to 10.

Understanding the World

We will be focusing on animals. We will be learning about animals and their habitats. Where in the world different animals live and locating their habitat on a map. We will also be looking at animal life cycles, including those of a frog and butterfly. We will be looking after some caterpillars and watching them turn into butterflies and visiting Hesketh Farm to learn more about animals and how to care for them.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be creating models using recycled materials, using a variety of tools and techniques to print and independently colour mix for a purpose. We will also be creating 3D sculptures using clay and air dough. Our focus artist will be Andy Warhol.
