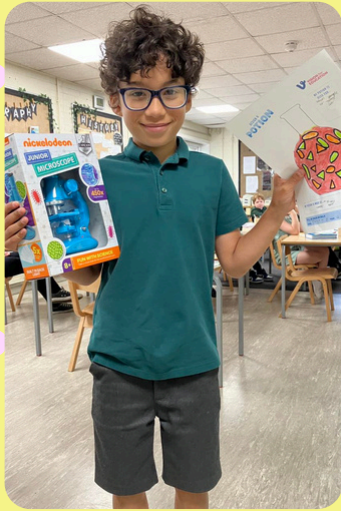




Whitecote Newsletter
